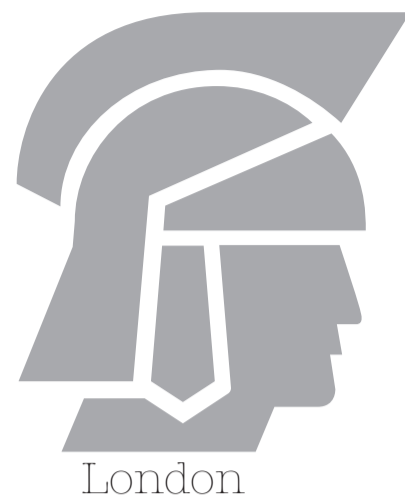
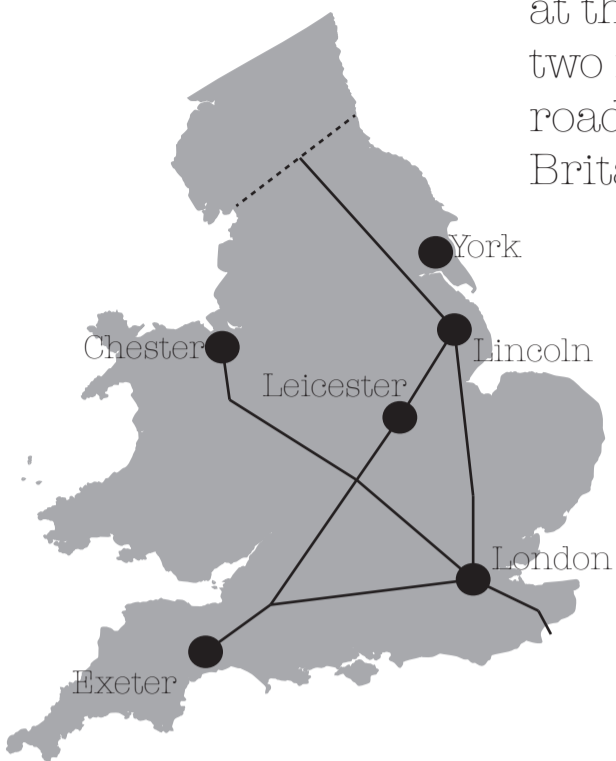

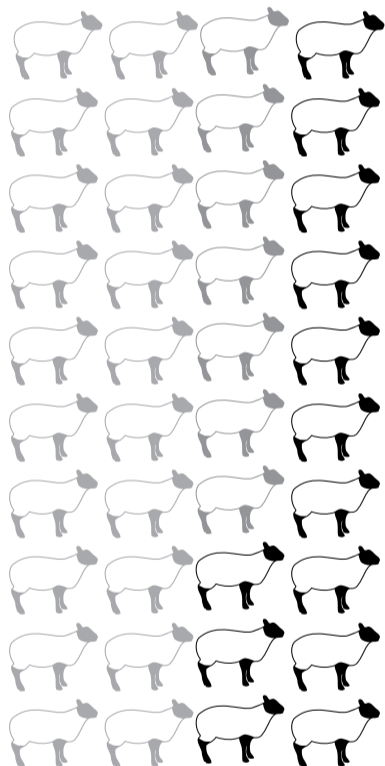
Lincoln was placed at the junction of two important roads in Roman Britain



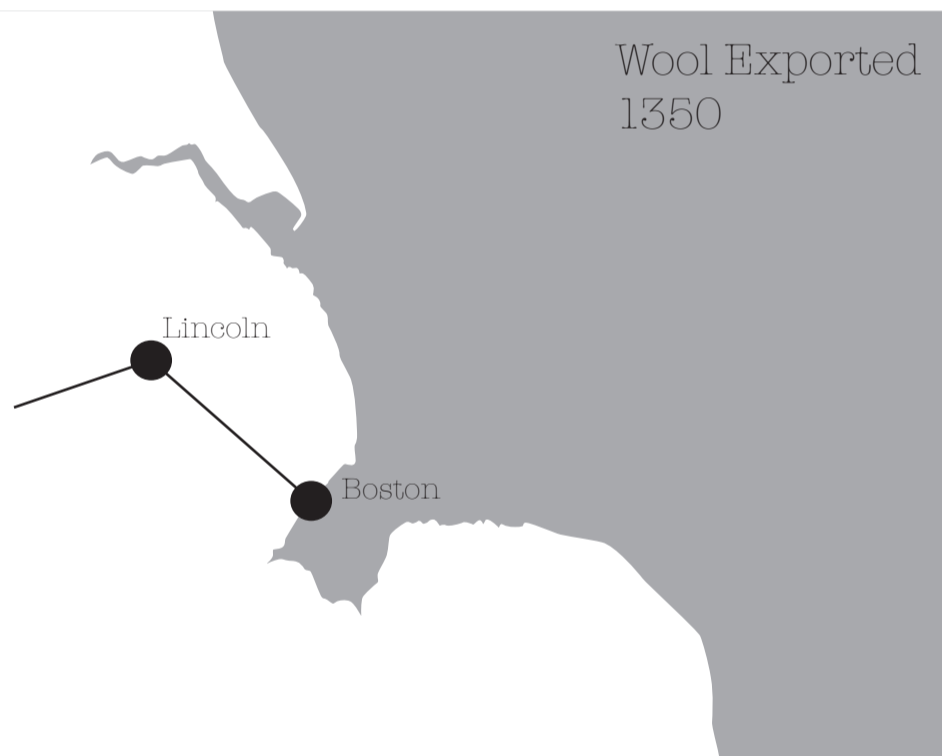
Roman Lincoln was 96 acres in size compared to Roman London which covered 330 acres

One third of medieval England's wool was exported through Lincoln and Boston via a waterway network

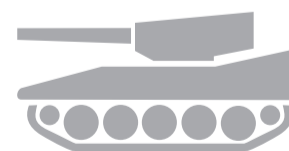
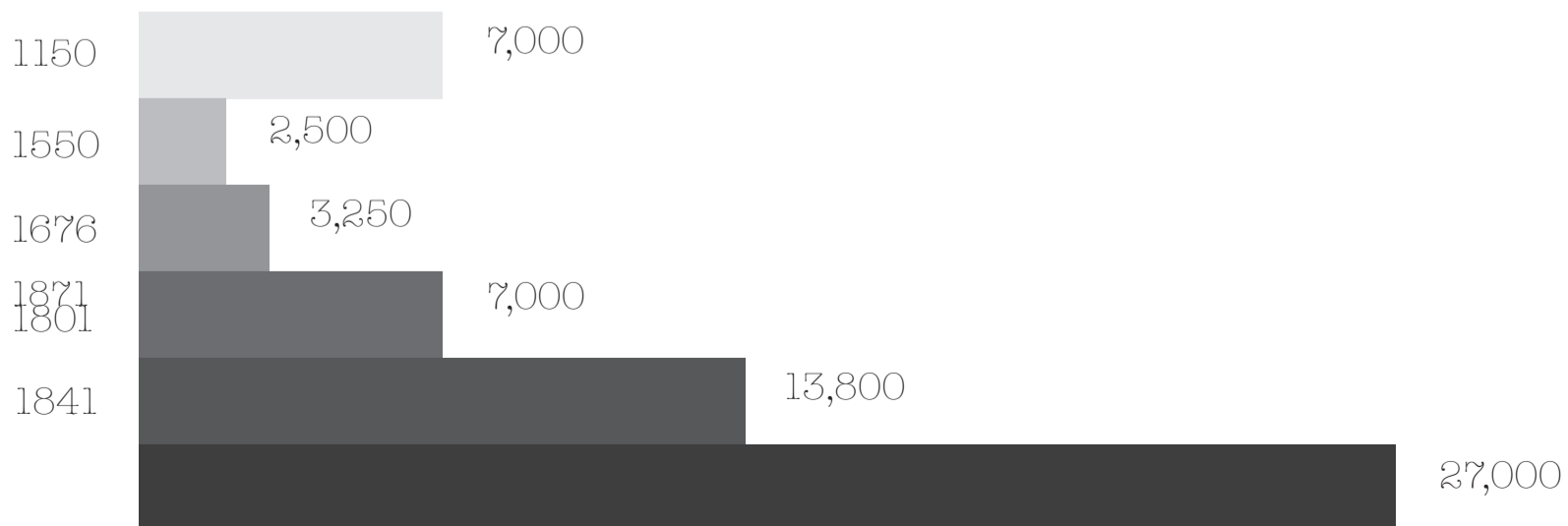
= 100 sacks of wool per year
